ordinance no. 1988-1

WHEREAS, it is determined that water billings are not being paid as promptly as desired; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that certain amendments be made to the present ordinances concerning water billings to attempt to rectify the problems;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

- All water bills are hereafter due on the 10th day of the month when mailed.
- Any water bills not paid within 10 days after a 2nd notice is mailed to any user shall be considered to be in Any water user whose bill is in default shall have his/her water service cut off by the Town.
- Once any water service shall be cut off to any user due to his/her bill being in default, the water service will only be turned on after payment of any bills outstanding and payment of \$10.00 service charge.
- 4. Any existing part of any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
- 5. Emergency Clause. being necessary It that finances and property of the Town are of extreme importance, and any loss thereof is declared to constitute an emergency in order that the peace, welfare and well-being of the community shall be sustained. Therefore, the ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage. Hayel Byrd & Mayer
