WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that an additional ordinance is needed to supplement the Arkansas State Law with regard to the orderly regulation of traffic upon the streets, alleys, private property and highways within the Town of Brookland.

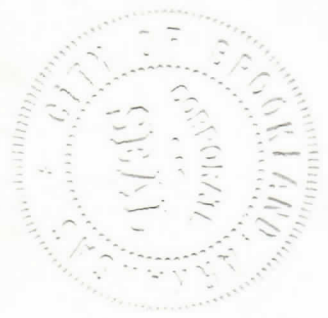
NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED THAT:

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to start or accelerate any motor vehicle upon the public way or upon any private driveway within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, in such a manner as to make a loud noise by means of motor exhaust or tires spinning, when no apparent necessity therefor exists.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle upon the public way within the Town of Brookland in a hazardous or negligent manner. Hazardous or negligent manner of driving is defined as the operation of any motor vehicle on the public way of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, without due care for the safety of others or their property upon the public way, or for the safety or property of such operator.

(c) Any person adjudged guilty of violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined in the amount of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

(d) **Emergency Clause.** Due to the immediate need for alternative traffic enforcement procedures, and in the interest of the health and safety of the citizenry of Brookland, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
