ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING EXCEPT WITHIN
PARKING AREAS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it hereby ordained by the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas that:

1. No vehicle, unless in an emergency, or to allow another vehicle or pedestrian to cross a street or to load and unload, shall be stopped or parked upon any street, alley or road within the corporate limits of Brookland, Arkansas.

2. No vehicle shall be stopped nor any other items be placed or allowed to remain so as to obstruct an alley, road or street and shall not be stopped or allowed to stand within any intersections of any street, alley or road.

3. Each person stopping or parking any vehicle who shall in any respect fail to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined in a sum of not less than 20⁰⁰ nor more than 50⁰⁰ for each offense.

4. It is hereby found that additional parking and street regulations are badly needed and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
