ORDINANCE NO. 2010-03

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland has some immediate problems with the elevated water storage tank which has been determined to be in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland has received funding from a General Improvement Funded – Community Enhancement Grant provided by the Arkansas Department of Rural Services in the amount of \$23,000.00 to make said repairs and it will cost the City of Brookland \$125.00 above the grant funds to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the painting is necessary to preclude potential health and safety hazards within the City of Brookland which would be health risk to the populace;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas does hereby ordain as follows:


That the City of Brookland, Arkansas is authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Leher Painting Enterprises, Inc. to make said repairs and apply the grant funds received from Arkansas Department of Rural Services for said repairs; and

That that the City of Brookland, Arkansas has authorized to pay Leher Painting Enterprises, Inc. the amount of \$125.00 to complete repairs to the elevated water storage tank.


EMERGENCY CLAUSE
