ORDINANCE NO. 2014-01

AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CHAINLINK SECURITY FENCE AROUND BROOKLAND UTILITIES SHOP, STREET DEPARTMENT SHOP, AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland recognizes the need to protect its property at 310 Hayes Street and citizens in the surrounding area due to growth and new families locating in the area; and

WHEREAS, the current fence does not adequately secure the wastewater treatment facilities, utility shop, street department shop and equipment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas has authorized the Mayor to waive competitive bidding on fence project to be constructed at 310 Hayes Street and enter into a contract with a developer according to State Statute 14-58-303 (2) (A) (i).

Emergency Clause


The city council of Brookland, Arkansas determines due to the growth of the populace of the citizens of Brookland in this area, the recent theft of one the city work vehicles, and the lack of security the current fence furnishes to protect not only the equipment but accessibility to the wastewater treatment facilities by individuals, that immediate action must be taken to alleviate said safety risk. Therefore, this ordinance shall be effective from and after its date of passage.
