

RESOLUTION NO. 77-2

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS
OF THE CITY OF Brookland TO MATCH
STATE AID CITY STREET FUNDS FOR THE
(Project)

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland understands State Aid
City Street funds are available for improvements to the city streets;
and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the top priority project
is Asphalt Coat of Bennett Street (Located Between Mathew and
Hinkle)

WHEREAS, the City understands their matching portion of this
project will be 30% of the total cost; and that 5% of the estimated
total project cost is submitted so preliminary engineering can begin;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE (BOARD OF DIRECTORS/CITY
COUNCIL) OF THE CITY OF Brookland, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I: The City of Brookland will participate in
accordance with its designated responsibility in this project.

SECTION II: The City of Brookland pledges its full
support and hereby authorizes and requests the Arkansas State High-
way and Transportation Department to initiate action to construct
this project.

SECTION III: The Mayor (Mayor/City Manager) is hereby
authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and
contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the improvements
on city streets.
