RESOLUTION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the railroad crossings at School Avenue, Matthews street, and Hinkle Street with the St. Louis-Southwestern Railway warrant safety improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City Of Brookland desires to participate in a program to increase the safety of all Railroad Crossings in Brookland,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS THAT:

1. The City of Brookland will close Mathews Street at the St. Louis-Southwestern Railway Crossing.
2. The City of Brookland will participate in the funding of a project to install flashing lights and a short-arm gates at the School Avenue and Kinkle Street Crossings.
3. The City of Brookland will obligate by appropriate means and provide satisfactory surety by either a Bond or certified check for 10% of the estimated project cost provided, however, that the final obligation in all cases will be 10% of the actual project cost.
