WHEREAS, the State law provides that the City Council, by resolution shall approve the millage rate on real and personal property;


BE IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED the City of Brookland will for the time being maintain the present rates.

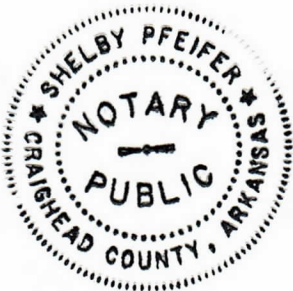

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:


