RESOLUTION NO. 2015-20

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING TO BE DECLARED A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS.

WHEREAS, that according to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-37-107 it is the duty of the Governor, the Auditor of State, and the Secretary of State, or any two (2) of them to ascertain from the federal census what cities of the second class are entitled to become cities of the first class;

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated §14-37-108 allows a city of the second class to apply for the advancement to a city of the first class in between times of a federal census upon request accompanied by a resolution adopted by the city council with proof showing the population of the city to be large enough to entitle it to such advancement;

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas recently paid for a special census due to it being in between times of a federal census; and


WHEREAS, the special census is satisfactory evidence that the population of Brookland, Arkansas is more than two thousand five hundred (2,500) inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:


That the City of Brookland, Arkansas hereby requests that the City of Brookland, Arkansas be so declared a city of the first class
